Bamboo Room

This is the main room for international conferences.

Equipped for 170 people and staff at a distance of 1.80 meters between each person.

Each person will have his or her own desk and will be able to view all the international conferences, both those given by the presenters as well as the virtual ones.

There will be live transmission on screens located in different parts of the main hall.

The place is open to protect people's safety and there will be awnings on the sides in case of rain.

It will be used for the Bamboo Workshop in the simultaneous rooms.

Chirripó Room

Equipped so that the exhibitor can give his presentation with a maximum of twenty face-to-face participants and up to 500 virtual participants, the moderator and the exhibitor are projected on a large screen.

The participants enter the place, in case the fields are full they will have to see the expositions virtually in the waiting rooms. In the hall, they will remain at a distance of 1.80 meters.

Corcovado Room

Equipped for the on-site moderator to project from Costa Rica to the virtual platform. Used only for virtual exhibitions with exhibitors who are not present in person. Admission will be virtual only and has space for 500 participants.

Tortuguero Room

Equipped for the on-site moderator to project from Costa Rica to the virtual platform. Used only for virtual exhibitions with exhibitors who are not present in person. Admission will be virtual only and has space for 500 participants.









Miravalles Room and Arenal Room

They will be 100% virtual, the moderators will be virtual and will not have a physical space at the event site.

Participants feeding area

In sketch space 6

The food area has space for 170 people spaced 1.80 meters apart. It will be buffet service and people must keep the proper distance to be served. There will be three food service stations for this area.

Food area for staff and hostesses

In sketch space 15

The food area for staff and hostesses will have space for 50 people spaced 1.80 meters apart. It will be buffet service and people must keep the proper distance to be served. A food service station will be set up for this area.

Medical area

In sketch space G

There will be an ambulance and an office with basic emergency medical services for the three days of the congress.

Parking

There will be space for more than 300 cars at the event site.

Restroom facilities

In sketch areas marked as restrooms.

Modality of the workshops
